Christmas Message: The Joy of the Lord is our Strength!

Christmas is a seasonal event that celebrates the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ, the son of God and the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a liturgical season that the church celebrates the beginning of our salvation history, the birth of our Savior Jesus Christ. Echoing the prophecy of Isaiah, "the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and shall name him Emmanuel" (Isaiah 7:14), St. Paul wrote, "When the fullness of time had come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to ransom those under the law, so that we might receive adoption" (Galatians 4:4). Therefore, Christmas is also a time to celebrate our common sonship as God's Children.

It is a season for generations when individuals and families in joy spend time together exchanging gifts and goodwill, showing gratitude to God, making merry, and an opportunity to be generous to the underprivileged and those who serve us. It has become part of the cultures of many peoples of the world.

But we must acknowledge that we have undergone many challenges as individuals and families, as a community, and as a country. Sometimes, the very essence of who we are as Christians is challenged.
